
Context and objectives





MAIN THEMES

- Reduce soil erosion and drought issues that affect local farmers;
- Increase the resilience of small-scale rice farmers by securing agricultural yields and developing additional new sources of incomes (fruits, timber);
- Fight against the local deforestation;



SPECIFIC CONTEXT

Due to the deforestation of mountainous areas in Khanh Hoa Province, soil erosion has brought a lot of sands to rice fields and caused serious droughts. As 80% of the villagers cultivate rice for a living, it has become a necessity to take action to preserve agricultural yields.

The plantation of trees along the rice fields and in deforested areas will help to preserve water resources and bring back a local biodiversity, while preventing sand shifts and helping farmers to continue to live from their traditional rice cultivation.



Tu bông village, Khanh Hoa province, Vietnam






- Tu Bong Village is located in Van Phuoc commune, Van Ninh district, Khanh Hoa province.
- Due to the deforestation of hillsides in the region, soil erosion has brought a lot of sands to rice fields and caused serious droughts.
- As 80% of the villagers cultivate rice for a living, it has become a necessity to take action to preserve agricultural yields.



SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

Securing the agricultural yields small-scale rice farmer

- Reducing erosion and sand shifts that seriously affect rice cultures;
- Raising awareness on sustainable agricultural practices: reducing slash and burn, preserving forests, using environmental services provided by trees for improved rice cultivation (organic fertilizer, pest control, water regulation, biodiversity...)
- Diversifying the production of healthy local food with fruits for villagers, in particular children;
- Adding new sources of income through the sales of timber and fruits;
- Creating links between villagers, children of the local welfare unit and partners through planting activities.
